• Sam Hornish Jr. has scored 282 points in eight superspeedway races this season, third-best among series regulars.

• Dodge is fielding two full-time entries in the series this year. Sam Hornish Jr. is competing for the series championship while Brad Keselowski and Parker Kligerman are sharing the driving duties in the second Penske Racing entry.

• Dodge claimed its first NASCAR championship in 2010 when Penske Racing's Brad Keselowski captured the driver's title. His average finish for the season was 5.2.

• Dodge has 41 wins in the series including seven in each of the last two seasons. The first Nationwide Series win came in 2002. Dodge had 11 wins in the series during the 2005 season.

• A Dodge has started from the pole 48 times.

DODGE QUOTES:

"Kentucky was basically the place where I got my big break in auto racing. After a run that I had there I got the deal with Panther to run full-time and won a couple Indy car races there. I've done a lot of testing there, from ARCA cars to Cup cars. It's notoriously bumpy. I remember Brad ran the middle groove all race last year and that takes a little getting used to because it's different than a lot of mile-and-a-halfs that you run. You want to be all the way at the bottom but it's just so rough down there."

It's kind of like a Texas or a Vegas in that sense, as far as the roughness goes. There are a lot of compromises that you have to make from a setup standpoint."
