Statement: Alternator

October 16, 2014, Auburn Hills, Mich. - Chrysler Group is voluntarily recalling approximately 470,000 cars and SUVs globally to resolve an alternator issue.

The action will eliminate a condition that may potentially drain the battery, leading to loss of electrical power which may increase steering effort, decrease brake effectiveness, cause stability-control deactivation, stalling and -- in the most severe case -- initiate fire at the alternator. **Chrysler Group is unaware of any related injuries or incidents involving fire.** The Company is aware of one accident that was potentially related to this campaign.

The recall is limited to vehicles equipped with electric hydraulic steering and 3.6-liter V-6 engines. Affected are model-year 2011-2014 Chrysler 300 and Dodge Charger sedans, Dodge Challenger coupes, Dodge Durango SUVs and model-year 2012-2014 Jeep Grand Cherokee SUVs.

An estimated 434,581 are in the U.S.; 16,080 are in Canada; 2,335 are in Mexico and 17,000 are outside the NAFTA region.

All affected customers will be notified next month by Chrysler Group. Service cost will be borne by the Company.
